



## ERASA NOTIFICATION #2 OF 2024

### FEI REGISTRATIONS AND NOVICE PHASES

For those of you are planning to register and ride at FEI events please note the following:

**ENDURANCE FEI RULE ARTICLE 832** (available on ERASA website under rules)

1. All FEI registrations, both horse and rider, are done through SAEF - [fei.admin@saef.org.za](mailto:fei.admin@saef.org.za) – contact person Robyn.

Please register timeously as Robyn deals with all FEI disciplines.

2. All new riders and horses being registered with FEI for the **first** time must have completed a novice phase as below and **only FEI approve or reject the novice phase.**

**RIDER:** ERASA manages this novice phase

2 X 40

Then only

2 x 80km

Restricted to a maximum speed of 16kmph.

***Rider can only compete in a FEI 1\* event 6 months after successful completion of their first novice event.***



**HORSE:** ERASA manages this novice phase

2 x 40km

Then only

2 x 80km

Restricted to speed of 16kmp.

***A horse may only compete in a FEI 1\* event 12 months after the successful completion of their first novice event.***

## **EXEMPTION**

**THE RIDER** will be granted an exemption from the novice qualifications if the rider has successfully completed a cumulative minimum of 480km in competitions over 80km or more in the three years (36 months) prior to the request.

**THE HORSE** will be granted an exemption from the novice qualifications if:

- (i)** It is eight years or older at the time of the request, and
- (ii)** In the three years (36 months) prior to the request it has successfully completed a cumulative minimum of 480km in Competition over distances of 80km, including at least one (1) competition of 80km or more at the age of either years or older.
